

Code of Conduct

The Birchwood Intermediate School Code of Conduct was developed by students, parents, and teachers in April 2003.

- I will respect myself, and other people's rights, personal space and feelings.
- I will respect school, student and community property.
- I will come to school prepared to take advantage of my opportunity to learn by respecting the teachers, fellow students, and the learning process.
- I will do my best to create a drug free, safe and positive environment.
- If I choose not to follow the code, I will accept the consequences of my actions.

Responsibilities of Students

A student enrolled in a school has the following responsibilities:

- (a) to attend school regularly and punctually;
- (b) to be ready to learn and actively engage in and diligently pursue the student's education;
- (c) to ensure that the student's conduct contributes to a welcoming, caring, respectful and safe learning environment;
- (d) to respect the rights of others in the school;
- (e) to refrain from, report and not tolerate bullying or bullying behaviour directed toward others in the school, whether or not it occurs on the school premises, during the instructional day or by electronic means;
- (f) to comply with the rules of the school and the policies of the education authority;
- (g) to co-operate with everyone authorized by the education authority to provide education programs and other services;
- (h) to be accountable to the student's teachers and other school staff for the student's conduct;
- (i) to contribute positively to the student's school community.
